ORDER

AND NOW, this 27th day of April 2017, upon consideration of Plaintiff’s, Alexandria Passe, Motion for Class Certification (“Motion”), Defendants’, 500 Jansen, Inc. (d/b/a “Lou Turk’s”) and Christopher L. Saddic, Answer in Opposition thereto, as well as the Memoranda of Law submitted in support thereof, it is ORDERED and DECREED that the said Motion will be, and hereby is, **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The following class is certified, pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure 1702 and 1710: **All individuals who, during any time since March 16, 2013, worked as Dancers at Defendants’ “Lou Turk’s” adult entertainment club located at 500 Powhattan Avenue in Essington, Pennsylvania.**

2. Plaintiff Alexandria Passe is appointed Class Representative of the Class, defined in paragraph 1 above, pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1709(2).

3. The law firms of Winebrake & Santillo, LLC and Saltz, Mongeluzzi, Barrett & Bendesky, P.C. shall serve as Class Counsel and, as such, shall represent the interests of the

above-captioned Plaintiff and All Class Members throughout all future proceedings pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1709(1).

4. The parties shall jointly submit a proposed Notice of Action, pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1712, within fourteen (14) days of the entry of this Order.
