ORDER

AND NOW, this 1st day of June, 2018, upon consideration of

Plaintiff's "Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of the Proposed Class Action Settlement" ("Motion"), the accompanying "Class Action Settlement Agreement" ("Settlement Agreement"), the accompanying "Notice of Settlement" ("Notice Form") and "Settlement Claim Form" ("Claim Form"), which are attached to the Settlement Agreement as Exhibits A and B, the accompanying memorandum of law, and all other papers and proceedings herein, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The proposed settlement between Plaintiff Alexandria Passe and the certified class and Defendants 500 Jansen, Inc. (d/b/a "Lou Turk's") and Christopher L. Saddic, as described in the Settlement Agreement, is **PRELIMINARILY APPROVED** subject to further submissions and further findings at the Fairness Hearing described in paragraph 5 below. The parties have until fourteen (14) days prior to the Fairness Hearing to file any papers in support of the final approval of the settlement and until seven (7) days prior to the Fairness Hearing to file papers in response to any objections to the settlement. In addition, Class Counsel shall have until fourteen (14) days prior to the Fairness Hearing to file all papers in support of their request for the payment of attorney's fees and litigation expenses in this case.

2. The Notice Form and Claim Form attached to this Order is approved as to form and content and shall be distributed to Class Members in the manner described in the Settlement Agreement.

3. In order to participate in the settlement of this case, Class Members must complete and return a Claim Form that is post marked no later than Sixty (60) days after the mailing of the Notice by Class Counsel.

4. Any objections to the Settlement must be post-marked no later than Sixty (60) days after the mailing of the Notice by Class Counsel.

5. A Fairness Hearing will be conducted at 8:30 AM October 4, 2018 in Courtroom 7, 201 West Front Street, Media, Pennsylvania 19063. During the Fairness Hearing, the Court will consider the parties' arguments in favor of final approval of the settlement, will consider any objections, and will hear argument from any individuals who wish to be heard.
